The Transport Minister Marc Garneau has authorized the construction of a new airport to replace the Mascouche airport which closed on November 15, 2016.

The Minister announced his decision in a letter addressed to the “Corporation de l’aéroport de Mascouche”. The new airport (aérodrome Terrebonne-Mascouche) will be located not far from the old one, but away from residential areas. Work is supposed to start soon with an opening in Summer 2017.

In the mean time, airplanes have been relocated in Lachute, Joliette, Cedars and St-Lazare and possibly other airports..




Solidworks 3D CAD software available from EAA brought to our attention by David Cyr
